Manitoba Junior Curling Tour Deer Lodge Icebreaker

Rules of Play and Regulations:

- The C.C.A. rules of curling for general play will be followed, except as noted below. In the event of a discrepancy, if the teams cannot come to an agreement, a fair play time out may be called and the MJCT representative for the night will make a final ruling. The team calling the fair play time out will not be charged with a regular time out.
- Games shall be 8 ends, with a 1:50 bell. The end in play and one further end shall be played. In the event of a tie, extra ends shall be played to determine a winner. Each team will receive 1 extra time out in the extra end. There is No break between game and extra end.
- Teams will have 2 one-minute time outs per game and a 3 minute 4th end break. Coaches or teams may call the time out. The coach from the team calling the time out may enter onto the ice surface, but may not enter the house.
- Coaches are on the honor system for time outs.
- One Spare will be allowed. I.e. One member different than what is registered on the MJCT website. You may play with your registered fifth and a spare. Spares must be of the same sex and can play up to the absent players normal position. Spares must not be registered on another team playing in the event.
- All Games must be played. Any forfeiture will result in loss of points for the event and prize money that was to be awarded.
- Tour committee members will be present at all draws and will act as umpire if a discrepancy arises that cannot be resolved by the teams involved.
